**CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS** are available (for up to 2 camp sessions) to any child qualifying for the federal free or reduced lunch program. Call HNC to confirm availability of funds, then attach documentation from your school district and apply the following rates.

**YOU PAY:**

Holiday Break Camp session:	\$40 mbr	\$52 non mbr
Winter Break Camp session:	\$50 mbr	\$65 non mbr

**Discounted Memberships:** Families whose children qualify for scholarship can purchase a family membership for just \$25.

**CANCELLATION/SESSION CHANGE POLICY:**

1. A full refund (less a \$20 processing fee per transaction) will be given for registered campers if a replacement is available from a waiting list **and** HNC is notified at least 14 days prior to the start of that camp session.
2. Campers withdrawing before the start of camp due to a medical emergency will receive a full refund (less a \$20 processing fee per transaction).
3. Registered campers requesting a session change will incur a \$10 fee per change, per camper. Session changes are only allowed if they are 14 days or more prior to the start of the registered camp.
4. HNC reserves the right to cancel camps with a 14-day notice if a minimum registration level is not met.
5. HNC reserves the right to cancel a camper registration if health and release forms are not received within 14 days prior to the start of the registered camp.
6. HNC reserves the right to cancel camp due to severe weather events that prohibit safe access to the facility and park without refund.
