Situated between UMD, **Hawk Ridge** and Duluth's outlying residential areas, **Hartley Park** is



a 660-acre island of wilderness. In summer, visitors fish for trout in **Hartley Pond & Tischer Creek**, while mountain bikers enjoy trails that wind through a mosaic of northern forest ecosystems.

The **Superior Hiking Trail** meanders through the park, providing hikers with stunning Lake Superior overlooks.



Winter is enjoyed on snowshoes or via cross country skis on the park's many groomed trails. A model in **green building technology**, the facility boasts a multitude of green building materials, over 13 kw in photovoltaic solar panels and a ground-source heat pump.
